Disciplinary Committee ordered student removed*

On 19 December 2023, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Cihan Dograyan of London, United Kingdom:

Allegations

Mr Cihan Dograyan, an ACCA student:

- Between 02 December 2018 and 27 September 2019, while he was employed by Firm A, improperly claimed personal expenses amounting to £14,545.05, in breach of Firm A's Expenses Policy.
- 2. Mr Dograyan's conduct in respect of the matters described in Allegation 1 above:
 - a. Was dishonest, in that Mr Dograyan claimed expenses from Firm A, when he knew he was not entitled to do so.
- 3. By reason of the above Mr Dograyan is guilty of misconduct pursuant to byelaw 8(a)(i) in respect of any or all of the matters at Allegations and 1 and 2 above.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Cihan Dograyan be removed from ACCA's student register with immediate effect and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £4,700.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.
