Disciplinary Committee ordered removal from Student Register*

On 28 March 2023, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Miss Yutong Wan from Beijing, China.

Allegations

- 1. Miss Yutong WAN ('Miss Wan') a registered student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ("ACCA"):
 - (a) On 25 August 2020, for the purpose of re-locating her September 2020 ACCA exams, Miss Wan submitted or caused to be submitted to ACCA, a falsified letter from the Office of Huagiao University / Overseas Chinese College, Capital University of Economics and Business.
 - (b) Miss Wan's conduct in respect of 1(a):
 - (i) was dishonest, in that she knew the document she submitted or caused to be submitted to ACCA described in 1(a) is false and was submitted by her for the purpose of relocating her September 2020 exams;
 - (c) By reason of her conduct in respect of any or all of the matters set out at 1(a) and/or 1(b) above, Miss Wan is guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i).

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Miss Wan Yutong be removed from the student register.
