## Disciplinary Committee ordered member excluded\*

On 19 October 2023, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Yuchen Hu of Beijing, China.

## **Allegations**

Yuchen Hu ('Mr Hu'), at all material times an ACCA trainee,

- 1. Applied for membership to ACCA on or about 21 April 2020 and in doing so purported to confirm in relation to his ACCA Practical Experience training record:
  - His Practical Experience Supervisor in respect of his practical experience training in the period from 31 a) October 2016 to 15 April 2020 was Person 'A' when Person 'A' did not supervise that practical experience training in accordance with ACCA's requirements as published from time to time by ACCA or at all
- 2. Mr Hu's conduct in respect of the matters described in Allegation 1 above was: -
  - In respect of Allegation 1a), dishonest, in that Mr Hu sought to confirm his Practical Experience a) Supervisor did supervise his practical experience training in accordance with ACCA's requirements or otherwise which he knew to be untrue.
