Disciplinary Committee ordered student removed*

On 21 March 2024, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Muneeb Ur Rehman of Canada:

Allegations

- 1) On 25 August 2020, Mr Muneeb Ur Rehman an ACCA student:
 - a) Used, an unauthorised item namely an electronic device capable of taking photographs, during ACCA's Corporate and Business Law (LW) on-demand remotely invigilated exam, to take a photograph of an exam question, contrary to Exam Regulations 5 and 14,
 - b) Caused or permitted the photograph referred to in Allegation 1a, to be shared with a person or persons unknown, contrary to Exam Regulation 10.
- 2) Further, Mr Muneeb Ur Rehman's conduct referred to in Allegation 1 above was:
 - a) Dishonest in that he,
 - (ii) Caused or permitted the photograph to be shared to assist another person or persons unknown to obtain an unfair advantage.
- 3) By reason of any or all of the facts at Allegations 1, and 2, Mr Muneeb Ur Rehman is:

a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i).

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Muneeb Ur Rehman be removed from ACCA student register with immediate effect and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £500.00.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect - ends –
