
The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Yunfei Yao...

Allegations

Mr Yunfei Yao, an ACCA student:

- 1. In relation to his RIE Strategic Business Leader (SBL) exam ("the Exam") on 03 September 2024:
 - Enabled and/or used, and/or caused or permitted a third party (or parties) to enable and use, (a) ToDesk remote access technology; and/or:
 - (b) Used a third-party proxy exam taker or takers to complete all or part of the Exam on his behalf via remote-access technology; and/or:
 - Used, and copied live exam content into, ChatGPT, generative artificial intelligence software, (c) to assist him and/or others in completinhg the Exam; and.or permitted a third party to do so; and/or:
 - (d) Shared or distributed, with a person or persons unknown, live exam content from the Exam on a chat messaging application; and/or permitted a third part to do so; and/or

(e)	By himself or by a third party, captured, alternatively caused or permitted to be captured, the exam check in process and/or live exam content; and/or
(f)	Had multiple tabs open on his desktop, including the Google search engine, during the exam.



- (a) Exam Refulation 5(a);(b) Exam Regulation 10;
- (c) Exam Regulation 11;
- (d) Exam Regulation 13;
- (e) Exam Regulation 15.
- 3. Further, in relation to allegations 1(a) to (f) above, such conduct, or any of it:
 - (a) Was dishonest in that he gained or intended to gain an unfair advantage for himself and/or others in the Exam and/or in a future exam; or in the alternative
 - (b) Such conduct demonstrated lack of integrity.
- 4. By reason of any or all of the above Mr Yunfei is:
 - (a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i); or in the alternative:
 - (b) Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii).

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee. -
