Disciplinary Committee ordered removal from student register with immediate effect*

On 18 December 2025, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Lovejeet Singh of West Bromwich, United Kingdom:

Allegations

1. Mr Lovejeet Singh who is a registered student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ("ACCA"):
 - (a) [PRIVATE].
 - (b) [PRIVATE].
2. Further to allegation 1, contrary to bye-law 10(b), between about 14 March 2024 and 16 July 2024, Mr Singh failed to bring promptly to the attention of ACCA that he may have become liable to disciplinary action (including any facts or matters relating to himself) [PRIVATE].
3. Further, by reason of any or all of matters above, Mr Singh is:
 - (a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i);

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Singh be removed from student register with immediate effect and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £600..

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

** An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect*
