## Member severely reprimanded\*

On 18 December 2025, the Consent Orders Chair of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) found proved the following allegations against a member, Mr Panayiotis Theodorou, of Limassol, Cyprus:

## **Allegations**

The Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) and Mr Panayiotis Theodorou (the Parties), agree as follows:

1. Mr Panayiotis Theodorou, an ACCA member, admits the following:

## Allegation 1

Pursuant to Bye-law 8(a)(vi), Mr Panayiotis Theodorou is liable to disciplinary action by virtue of the disciplinary action taken against him by the Disciplinary Committee of the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Cyprus on 26 June 2024.

The Consent Orders Chair ordered that Mr Panayiotis Theodorou be severely reprimanded and pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £2,014.50.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's finding and orders by way of a press release, as soon as practicable.
