Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 09.30am on 28 August 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact adminadjudication@accaglobal.com to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Cyr Koukponou.

Allegations

Mr Cyr Koukponou, a student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ("ACCA"):

1. On 05 September 2025, during a remotely invigilated Financial Management examination ("the exam"), used, or permitted the use of, an unauthorised item, namely an electronic device capable of videoing ("the unauthorised item"), contrary to Exam Regulation 5(a) and/or 5(b).
2. Caused, or permitted, during the exam the videoing of exam content presented to him ("the video"), contrary to Exam Regulation 11 and/or 13.
3. Caused, or permitted, the sharing of the video with a third party or parties unknown, contrary to Exam Regulation 13.
4. Mr Koukponou's conduct set out in Allegation 1, 2 and/or 3 above was:
 - a) Dishonest in that he gained, or intended to gain, an unfair advantage for himself and/or others in the exam and/or a future ACCA exam via the conduct; or
 - b) In the alternative, such conduct demonstrates a failure to act with integrity.

5. By reason of any, or all, of his conduct set out in the Allegation 1 to 4 above, Mr Koukponou is:
- a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i); or
 - b) In the alternative, liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii) in respect of Allegations 1, 2 and/or 3 above.
