Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08.30am on 28 August 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact adminadjudication@accaglobal.com to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Saksham Motwani.

Allegations

Mr Saksham Motwani, a student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ('ACCA'):

1.a) During an on-demand Corporate and Business Law (LW) - ENG remotely invigilated exam ("the exam") taken on 14 January 2025:

- (i) Was in possession of an unauthorised item, namely a mobile phone, during the exam, contrary to Exam Regulation 5(b); and/or:
- (ii) Failed to comply with the Exam Guidelines to "move mobile phones out of arm's reach" and/or by having a mobile phone on his desk during the exam, breached Exam Regulation 1; and/or:
- (iii) Used the said mobile phone during the exam, contrary to Exam Regulation 5(a); and/or
- (iv) Told the Proctor he was not using "any device", which was false or misleading information, contrary to Exam Regulation 3.

2. The conduct referred to in Allegation 1 above, or any of it, was:
 - a) Dishonest, in that Mr Motwani intended to gain an unfair advantage in the exam attempt and/or to assist others in the exam and/or a future exam; or in the alternative:
 - b) Such conduct demonstrates a failure to act with integrity.
3. By reason of any or all of his conduct, Mr Motwani is:
 - a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to Bye-law 8(a)(i); or in the alternative:
 - b) Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to Bye-law 8(a)(iii), in respect of any or all of the matters in Allegation 1.

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
