Member reprimanded*

On 05 February 2026, the Consent Orders Chair of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) found proved the following allegations against a member, Mr Amos Pak Tak Lun, of Kowloon, Hong Kong:

Allegations

Mr Amos Pak Tak Lun, an ACCA Fellow, admits the following:

1. Pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(vi), Mr Pak Tak Lun is liable to disciplinary action by virtue of the disciplinary action taken against him by the Disciplinary Committee of the Accounting and Financial Reporting Council in Hong Kong (AFRC) on 21 August 2025.

The Consent Orders Chair ordered that Mr Pak Tak Lun be reprimanded and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £1,316.00.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's finding and orders by way of a press release, as soon as practicable.
