## **Disciplinary Committee ordered exclusion from membership\***

On 13 February 2026, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Shahzaib Ahmed Khan, of London, England.

### Allegations

Mr Shahzaib Ahmed Khan (Mr Khan), a member of ACCA:

1. Between 1 July 2023 and 30 November 2024 submitted false expenses claims to Firm A, being his then employer, amounting to approximately £29,552.25.
2. By reason of the matters referred to in paragraph 1 above, was dishonest in that he knew the expenses claims he submitted were false and did not represent expenses to which he was entitled to receive reimbursement.
4. Failed to co-operate with ACCA's Investigating Officer in breach of Complaints and Disciplinary Regulation 3(1) in that he failed to respond at all to any or all of ACCA's correspondence dated:
  - a) 29 July 2025;
  - b) 30 July 2025 and
  - c) 12 August 2025.
5. By reason of the above conduct, Mr Khan is:
  - a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i).

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Shahzaib Ahmed Khan be excluded from membership and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £6,620.00.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.
