The case to be heard on this day concerns Ms Keshni Soomaroosing .

Allegations

Ms Keshni Soomaroosing being an ACCA Student:

1. On 14 May 2024 and 16 May 2024 submitted or caused to be submitted one or more of the documents purporting to have been issued by the University of Mauritius set out in Schedule A to the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ("ACCA").
2. In respect of Allegation 1 Ms Soomaroosing was dishonest in that she sought to represent that:
 - a. She was submitting genuine documentation when she was not; and/or
 - b. That she was eligible for exemptions from ACCA examinations which she was not.
3. In the alternative, on the same facts, in respect to the conduct referred to in Allegation 1, Ms Soomaroosing failed to demonstrate integrity.
4. By reason of her conduct in respect of any or all of the matters set out at 1 and/or 2 above, Ms Soomaroosing is:

(i) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to Bye-law 8(a)(i).

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
