Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08:00am on 07 July 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Oscar Luo Yu Han.

Allegations

Oscar Luo Yu Han ('Mr Han'), at all material times an ACCA affiliate,

1. In relation to his Online ACCA Practical Experience training record;
 - a) Claimed he had undertaken part of his ACCA practical experience training as a Consultant at Firm A which was untrue as he knew.
 - b) Claimed Person B had been his practical experience supervisor at Firm A for the purposes of the practical experience training referred to above which further was untrue as he knew.
 - c) On or about 18 May 2017 approved, or caused to be approved, in the name of Person B his time claim in relation to his purported experience working for Firm A.
 - d) On various dates between May 2017 and February 2020 approved, or caused to be approved, in the name of Person B seven of his performance objectives.

2. Mr Han's conduct in relation to Allegation 1 above,
 - a) Was dishonest by reason of the matters referred to in Allegation 1
 - b) Demonstrates a failure to act with integrity.
3. By reason of his conduct described above Mr Han is guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i).

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
