Disciplinary Committee ordered severe reprimand*

On 14 July 2026, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Ngan Hing Hon, of Hong Kong.

Allegations

1. Pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(vi), Mr Ngan Hing Hon, an ACCA Member, is liable to disciplinary action by virtue of the disciplinary action taken against him by the Accounting and Financial Reporting Council of Hong Kong on 20 November 2025.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Ngan Hing Hong be severely reprimanded and to pay costs of £5,000.00 to ACCA.
