Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08:00am on 04 June 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact adminadjudication@accaglobal.com to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Ms Lee Hui Ting.

Allegations

Ms Lee Hui Ting, a student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), in respect of her on-demand remotely invigilated Strategic Business Reporting exam taken on 05 December 2024 ('the Exam'):

1. Copied, photographed, videoed or otherwise reproduced, and/or allowed a third person to copy, photograph, video or otherwise reproduce, ACCA Exam content, contrary to Exam Regulation 13.
2. Distributed, and/or allowed distribution by a third party, of ACCA Exam content, contrary to Exam Regulation 13.
3. Miss Lee Hui Ting's conduct in respect of any or all of the above was:
 - a) Dishonest in that she copied or allowed the copying of ACCA Exam content with intent to gain unfair advantage for herself and/or another.
 - b) Dishonest, in that she distributed or allowed distribution for personal gain and/or to gain unfair advantage for herself and/or another.

c) Such conduct demonstrates a failure to act with integrity.

4. By reason of any or all her conduct, Miss Ting is:

a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i); or in the alternative;

b) Liable to disciplinary action by virtue of bye-law 8(a)(iii).

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
