Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 09.30am on 19 June 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Teewanan Juggoo.

Allegations

Mr Teewanan Juggoo ("Mr Juggoo"), a fellow member of Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ("ACCA):

1. Since on or around 6 March 2024, Mr Juggoo has failed to make himself available for monitoring by ACCA as set out in Regulation 14(1) of the Global Practising Regulations 2003 (as amended on 9 February 2024, 1 April 2024, 11 November 2024 and 1 January 2025).
2. Since on or around 6 March 2024, Mr Juggoo has failed to supply ACCA with all the information necessary to enable it to complete its monitoring process, contrary to Regulation 14(2) of the Global Practising Regulations 2003 (as amended on 9 February 2024, 1 April 2024, 11 November 2024 and 1 January 2025).
3. Since on or around 6 March 2024, Mr Juggoo has failed to co-operate with ACCA in its monitoring and enforcement of compliance with the Global Practising Regulations 2003, contrary to 14(3) of the Global Practising Regulations 2003 (as amended on 9 February 2024, 1 April 2024, 11 November 2024 and 1 January 2025).
4. By reason of any or all of his conduct set out in Allegation 1 to 3, Mr Juggoo is:

- a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i); or
- b) In the alternative, liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii) in respect of Allegation 2 and/or 3.
