Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08.30am on 06 October 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact adminadjudication@accaglobal.com to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Ms Mitali Solanki.

Allegations

Ms Mitali Solanki ("Ms Solanki"), a student of ACCA, during on-demand remotely invigilated Financial Reporting (FR) exam taken on 04 September 2025 ("the exam"):

1. Caused, or permitted, a third party and/or parties to be present in the room she was sitting the exam, contrary to Exam Regulation 19.
2. Caused, or permitted, a third party and/or parties to use an unauthorised item, namely a mobile phone with camera ("the unauthorised item"), contrary to Exam Regulation 5(a) and 5(b).
3. Caused, or permitted, a third party and/or parties to use the unauthorised item to take photographs and/or recordings of exam content presented to her, contrary to Exam Regulation 11 and 13.
4. Whispered and/or spoke out loud during the exam, contrary to Exam regulation 15..
5. Ms Solanki's conduct set out in Allegation 1, 2, 3 and/or 4 above was:
 - a) Dishonest in that she gained or intended to gain, an unfair advantage for herself and/ or others in the exam and/or a future ACCA exam via the conduct set out in Allegation 1,2 3and/or 4 above;

- b) In the alternative, such conduct demonstrates a failure to act with integrity.
6. Contrary to Regulation 3(1) of the Complaints and Disciplinary Regulations 2014 (as amended), Ms Solanki failed to co-operate with the consideration or investigation of this complaint, in that she failed to respond fully, or at all, to ACCA's correspondences dated:
- a) 16 January 2026
 - b) 17 February 2026
 - c) 09 March 2026
 - d) 17 March 2026
7. By reason of any, or all, of her conduct set out in Allegation 1 to 6 above, Ms Solanki is:
- a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i);
 - b) In the alternative, liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii) in respect Allegations 1,2, 3, 4 and/or 6 above.
