Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08.30am on 14 October 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Zeeshan Jabbar.

Allegations

Mr Zeeshan Jabbar ('Mr Jabbar'), at all material times an ACCA trainee:

1. Applied for membership to ACCA on or about 8 December 2022 and in doing so claimed in his ACCA Practical Experience training record that he had achieved the following Performance Objectives:
 - Performance Objective 1: Ethics and professionalism
 - Performance Objective 2: Stakeholder relationship management
 - Performance Objective 3: Strategy and innovation
 - Performance Objective 4: Governance, risk and control
 - Performance Objective 5: Leadership and management
 - Performance Objective 8: Analyse and interpret financial reports
 - Performance Objective 18: Prepare for and plan the audit and assurance process
 - Performance Objective 19: Collect and evaluate evidence for an audit or assurance engagement
 - Performance Objective 20: Review and report on the findings of an audit or assurance engagement

2. Mr Jabbar's conduct in respect of the matters described in Allegation 1 above demonstrates a failure to act with integrity given the corresponding statements to the performance objectives were not written in his own words as required by ACCA.
3. In the further alternative to Allegation 2, such conduct was reckless in that Mr Jabbar paid no or insufficient regard to ACCA's requirements to ensure the corresponding statements to the performance objectives referred to in Allegation 1 were in his own words as required by ACCA.
4. By reason of his conduct, Mr Jabbar is guilty of misconduct pursuant to ACCA byelaw 8(a)(i) in respect of any or all the matters set out at 1 to 3 above.
