Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08.30am on 18 September 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact adminadjudication@accaglobal.com to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Aon Amjad.

Allegations

Mr Aon Amjad, a registered student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ("ACCA"):

1. Between 10 July 2023 and 31 May 2024, Mr Amjad forged signatures of Person A and/or Person B on at least 2 Independent Auditor's Reports (the "Signed Audit Reports") and 11 Agreed-Upon Procedure ("AUP") Report on Statement of Sales (the "Signed Statement of Sales") (see Annex 1).
2. Between 14 May 2024 and 22 May 2024, Mr Amjad submitted 4 Financial Statements ("Four Financial Statements") to Company A's clients without the completion of the internal review process, contrary to R113.1(b) of Subsection 113 of the Fundamental Principle of Professional Competence and Due Care in ACCA's Code of Ethics and Conduct (see Annex 1).
3. Mr Amjad's conduct at allegation 1 above was:
 - a) Dishonest, in that he forged the signatures of Person A and/or Person B in the Signed Documents without the relevant permission or authority; or in the alternative:
 - b) Such conduct demonstrates a failure to act with integrity.

4. By reason of the conduct described in any or all of the matters set out at allegation 1, 2, and 3, Mr Amjad is:
- a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i); or in the alternative
 - b) Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii).
