Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 09.30am on 30 September 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact adminadjudication@accaglobal.com to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Hezron Obonyo Kamsingi.

Allegations

Mr Hezron Obonyo Kamsingi, an ACCA Student, in respect of his centre based Audit & Assurance (AA) ACCA Exam taken on 1 December 2025 ("the Exam"):

1. Failed to promptly comply in all respects with instructions issued by the Exam supervisor and/ or invigilator(s) to relinquish his workstation to allow the exam to be terminated, contrary to Exam Regulation 2;
2. Conducted himself in an inappropriate way towards the Exam supervisor and/or invigilator(s) by using vulgar and/or offensive and/or abusive language contrary to Exam Regulation 18.
3. Conducted himself in an inappropriate way contrary to Exam Regulation 18 by doing one or more the following:
 - (a) Punching the computer screen and damaging it;
 - (b) Punching the computer table;
 - (c) Banging the keyboard against the desk;
 - (d) Kicking a dustbin on his way out of the Exam.

4. Further to any or all of Allegations 2 and 3, failed to comply with R 115.1 of Subsection 115 - Professional Behaviour, of the Code of Ethics and Conduct (2025) in that he engaged in conduct that he knew or should have known might discredit the profession.
5. By reason of any or all of the above, Mr Hezron Kamsingi is:
 - (a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to Bye-law 8(a)(i); or in the alternative:
 - (b) Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to Bye-law 8(a)(iii).

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
