

# Important note about a difference in functionality between practice tests and live exams

#### **PDF** exhibits


Please be aware that PDF exhibits look and behave slightly differently in practice tests and live exams.

## Selecting text in a PDF exhibit


In a practice test, you can immediately select text in a PDF exhibit, either to highlight, strikethrough or copy it. In the live exam, you can't immediately select the text – you need to switch from 'Move Tool' to 'Text Tool' in order to be able to select text. This is illustrated below:




Once the Text Tool is selected in the live exam, you will be able to select text in the PDF exhibit.

## Display of selected text in a PDF exhibit

In a practice test, once you have selected some text it will have highlighting/shading applied to it:




## In the live exam, selected text is greyed out:



#### Find Tool in the PDF exhibit

The 'Find Tool' appears at the top of the PDF exhibit toolbar in a practice test. In the live exam, it appears on the left hand side of the PDF exhibit.

## **Copying and Pasting into Spreadsheet Responses**

- In the CBE Practice Platform, you can paste text copied from exhibits, requirements/tasks or the scratchpad into a spreadsheet response either by selecting the cell, double-clicking the cell or selecting the formula bar.
- In the live exam, you can only do this by double-clicking the cell or selecting the formula bar and then pressing Ctrl-V.
