- The examiner's approach article gives insight into what the examiner is looking for in terms of exam performance, covering the main themes of the exam, advice on exam technique and tips on how to succeed.
- In the 'five minutes with the examining team' video the P1 qualification technical adviser gives advice about what the examining team are looking for and strategies for passing the exam.
- Examiner's reports are an essential study resource, providing a commentary on candidates' performance and highlighting good performance and where performance could be improved. Use them to learn about mistakes that students commonly make in exams and how to avoid them.

TECHNICAL ARTICLES

There are many useful P1 technical articles and videos available on the ACCA website, which supplement the knowledge in Approved Content materials. It is essential that you take time to use these resources and make notes of what each one is about, to consolidate your learning. Technical articles are regularly updated to reflect examiners' comments made about the exams and new syllabus areas, and are all extremely useful (not just the most recent ones!) They can be found here.

In the 'exam technique' section on the technical articles page there are some particularly useful articles to highlight.

- "Read the mind of the P1 marker" is intended to give real insight into the mind of the marker and to help build understanding of what they are looking for when they mark P1 scripts.
- 'P1 a guide to using the examiner's reports' takes you through how to make best use of the examiner's reports as part of the revision phase,
- and 'P1 a guide to reflection for retake students' helps those retaking P1, supporting the reflection process using the examiner's reports.

PAST EXAMS

ACCA past exams can be a useful source of question practice. Using the most recent exams is best, and it's particularly helpful if students practise specific questions which are relevant to the subject they're learning about, with time constraints applied. Remember, the answers included with past exams are far more comprehensive than will be expected in the exam! See past exams for P1.



Tips for success

✓ When practising past exam questions, remember it's quality not quantity that counts. Make sure you work questions through, in exam conditions if possible, without referring to the answers. Once you have finished, spend time looking through your answers and reflecting on how you have done. Remember, there is no point in learning answers to past questions, because they won't come up again – instead, you need to build up your ability to apply your knowledge flexibly, to the specific scenarios and requirements in your exam.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE SUPPORT

P1 can present challenges for those whose first language is not English. BPP University's English language support for ACCA offers great resources to help, and for P1 modules are available around writing introductions and conclusions, writing press releases and proof reading your work. There are also other units which will be useful for P1, for example how to skim read and scan longer texts. **Find out more**.
