- all papers covered various interesting and relevant scenarios with an appropriate mix of style and diversity with the criteria met
- the rigorous analysis of exam results provides integrity to the process
- that there were no aspects of the exams that gave her cause for concern and that she was satisfied with all aspects.

Based on the evidence presented and subsequent discussion, the Board agreed to ratify the September 2024 examination results.
