4. EXAMINATION RESULTS GOVERNANCE REVIEW

The Board noted the Exams Governance Report which had been circulated in advance of the meeting to the Board. The Board received a presentation from the Director – Professional Qualifications and the Qualifications Data Science Lead on the delivery of exams and the results of the December 2024 exam session.

The Board also received an oral report from the Chief External Examiner on her review of the exam papers, confirming the following:

- It was confirmed that all exams were comparable in standard and there were no overlaps.
- All papers covered various interesting and relevant scenarios with an appropriate mix of style and diversity with the criteria met.
- The rigorous analysis of exam results provides integrity to the process.
- That there were no aspects of the exams that gave her cause for concern and that she was satisfied with all aspects.

Based on the evidence presented and subsequent discussion, the Board <u>agreed</u> to ratify the December 2024 examination results.

The Board also received a presentation on the Long-term Pass Rate Trends. The Board discussed the information provided and indicated that the information provided was comprehensive and insightful.
