## ACCA Community Day 2023 concludes successfully Gathering accounting and finance elites for the charitable rickshaw race

ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) Hong Kong has today successfully held its 25th ACCA Community Day at Chater Road, Sunday Pedestrian Precinct, Central. Under the theme of '25 Years of Love and Care. Run Ahead to a Better Future', ACCA is honoured to have Financial Secretary Paul Chan Mo-po as the guest of honour. This year's event gathered over 300 elites from accountancy firms, multinational companies, local organisations and institutions to contribute to the charities and has successfully raised around HK\$1.1 million. Among all the participating teams, the winner of the rickshaw race is team EY FSO.

The ACCA Community Day, an annual highlight event in the accounting and finance industry since its inception in 1997, has become one of the most recognised charitable events in Hong Kong. With the relaxation of anti-pandemic policies, the ACCA Community Day returns in physical format after three years. Over the past 25 years, the ACCA Community Day has brought the business community and the general public together with charitable causes, raising over HK\$23 million to help the underprivileged, bringing positive energy to society as well as creating a better future through contributing to the charities.
