IFRS 15 shall be applied in preparing financial statements for annual reporting periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018. The first sets of financial statements that were affected by IFRS 15 were released in early 2019. What are the actual impacts on the published financial statements? How does it affect the financial performance of listed companies?
