T Level in Accounting

From September 2022, there'll also be a new accounting qualification in England available as an alternative to A levels. The T Level qualification is a two-year course equivalent to three A levels and open to anyone aged 16-18 in England. It'll give you a head start on your career, by developing the skills employers look for and enabling you to explore a future in finance through a work placement. Once completed, you can either continue onto the ACCA qualification or an apprenticeship.
