## Consent form – Data protection

When ACCA collects personal information, we are required by law to be fair in notifying individuals on how their information will be managed and to inform them of their rights. But more than that, we want to be transparent, open and ethical in our practices.

ACCA's **Data protection notice** provides information on how personal data will be used.

For individuals under the age of 16 to join ACCA (or under the age of 18 in Kenya) we require a parent, guardian or individual with parental responsibility to complete this form providing consent for ACCA to collect and use the applicant's personal data.
