Reception

Please see map detail below:

- 1 Main reception – please access the dedicated ACCA entrance via Adelphi Terrace (Thames side).
- 2 The main entrance from John Adam Street should be used for any guests with accessibility requirements as this entrance is fully accessible. Lifts and public areas are designed for wheelchairs and the building has accessible toilets.

GETTING THERE

By underground

The nearest underground stations are Charing Cross (on the Bakerloo and Northern lines) and Embankment (on the Circle, District and Bakerloo lines). Both stations are only 5–10 minutes walk from our Adelphi offices.

By car

There is no parking available at the Adelphi. A NCP car park is available in Bedfordbury, London WC2N 4BP.

By taxi

Typical journey time from main line rail terminals:
Kings Cross, Euston, St Pancras (for Luton airport), Liverpool Street (for Stansted airport), Paddington (for Heathrow airport), Victoria (for Gatwick airport) = 20–30 minutes.
Waterloo = 10 minutes.

From Heathrow

Take the Piccadilly line to Leicester Square, then the Northern line to Charing Cross.

From Gatwick

Take the Gatwick Express to Victoria, then the District or Circle line to Embankment.

From Charing Cross station

Turn right from the station frontage onto The Strand, right onto Adam Street and at the end of Adam Street and turn right onto Adelphi Terrace – ACCA's entrance is on the right.

From Embankment station

Follow Villiers Street up the hill, turn right into John Adam Street. Turn right into Robert Street and then left at the end of Robert Street onto Adelphi Terrace – ACCA's entrance is on the left.
