

*As per IBCC's notification (dated 24 February 2015), graduates of the ACCA Foundation Diploma from 2014 onwards can claim the Intermediate equivalence certificate from IBCC on passing three additional examinations (Business Mathematics, Statistics and Principles of Economics) from any technical board across Pakistan. Intermediate, Bachelors and Masters are optional qualifications with ACCA, subject to terms and conditions. Check ACCA's exemption database as you may get exemptions from knowledge and skills exams.
